



Enjoy peaceful paddling in the unique mangrove habitat of the Placencia Lagoon.

Take in the majesty and peace of our mangrove cathedrals that are found in the Placencia Lagoon just behind the resort property. Your guide will help you spot various birds, both native and migrant, crabs, iguanas and perhaps a crocodile. It is also possible to see dolphins and manatees. This tour is best done in the early morning or late afternoon as the likelihood of wildlife sightings is higher at these times.



Take a kayak out from the beach in front of the resort and paddle to nearby False Caye!



Snorkel the patch reefs around the island and explore the mystique of the mangrove-lined inner lagoon. Common species below the waves include angelfish, spotted eagle rays and lobster. In the canopy above there are brown pelicans, cormorants and the occasional osprey. The perfect way to start your day with some marine adventure.



Home to upwards of 40 bird species, and even more during periods of migration, birders both experienced and new get to see plenty without the hassle of a long van ride. Common species include Roadside Hawks, Chachalacas, Black Headed Trogons, Tropical Kingbirds, Little Blue Herons, Common Black Hawks, Cinnamon Hummingbirds and Tropical Mockingbirds.



Want to literally hear the call of the wild? Take a boat ride along the southern coast of Belize en route to Monkey River to satisfy your curiosity.

Nimli Punit (which means 'Big Hat' in Ketchi Maya), is a small hilltop site that is notable for its carved stellae covered in hieroglyphs, its royal tombs and its ancient observatory. After a hearty lunch at Pearleen's Cafe you will be whisked away to the Belize Spice Farm. Here you will get your hands on cardamom, vanilla, allspice, nutmeg, and black pepper plants. Touch and taste these spices and learn about their origins, uses, cultivation, and processing. You'll never look at your spice rack in the same way again!



Ancient architecture and culture as you've never experienced it.

The word Xunantunich means 'Maiden of the Rock' in Mopan Maya, and is a lovingly restored ancient Maya city, with a recently discovered king's burial chamber full of ceremonial items. It is one of the few sites in Mesoamerica that you can still climb to the top of the main temple. This tour can be combined with a stop for a swim at the inland Blue Hole, or with a cave tubing adventure.



Reef? Check. Marine life encounters? Check!

The Belize barrier reef system is the second largest in the world and boasts hundreds of world class snorkeling sites. Here in southern Belize we are blessed with sites like Silk Caye and Laughingbird Caye, both of which reside within national parks. Whether you are an experienced snorkeler or if you are new to the marine world there is a world of wonder to be found just below the surface.



Go deep! Visit a haven for a host of brilliantly colored Caribbean reef dwellers.

Belize boasts the second largest barrier reef in the world: the reef wall runs more or less parallel to our entire coastline! The southern portion of the reef offers divers a wide variety of pristine sites to choose from. The top of the reef wall generally starts around 40 feet in most places and then drops off into the abyss. Cruise along the wall looking for turtles eagle rays, lobsters, moray eels and the occasional reef shark all the while admiring some of the most robust and colorful hard coral, sponges and gorgonians in the region. Ask your concierge about special trips to places like Glover's reef and South Water Caye.
